This is off the tourist track. Mostly locals. The bar is downstairs and the restaurant upstairs.





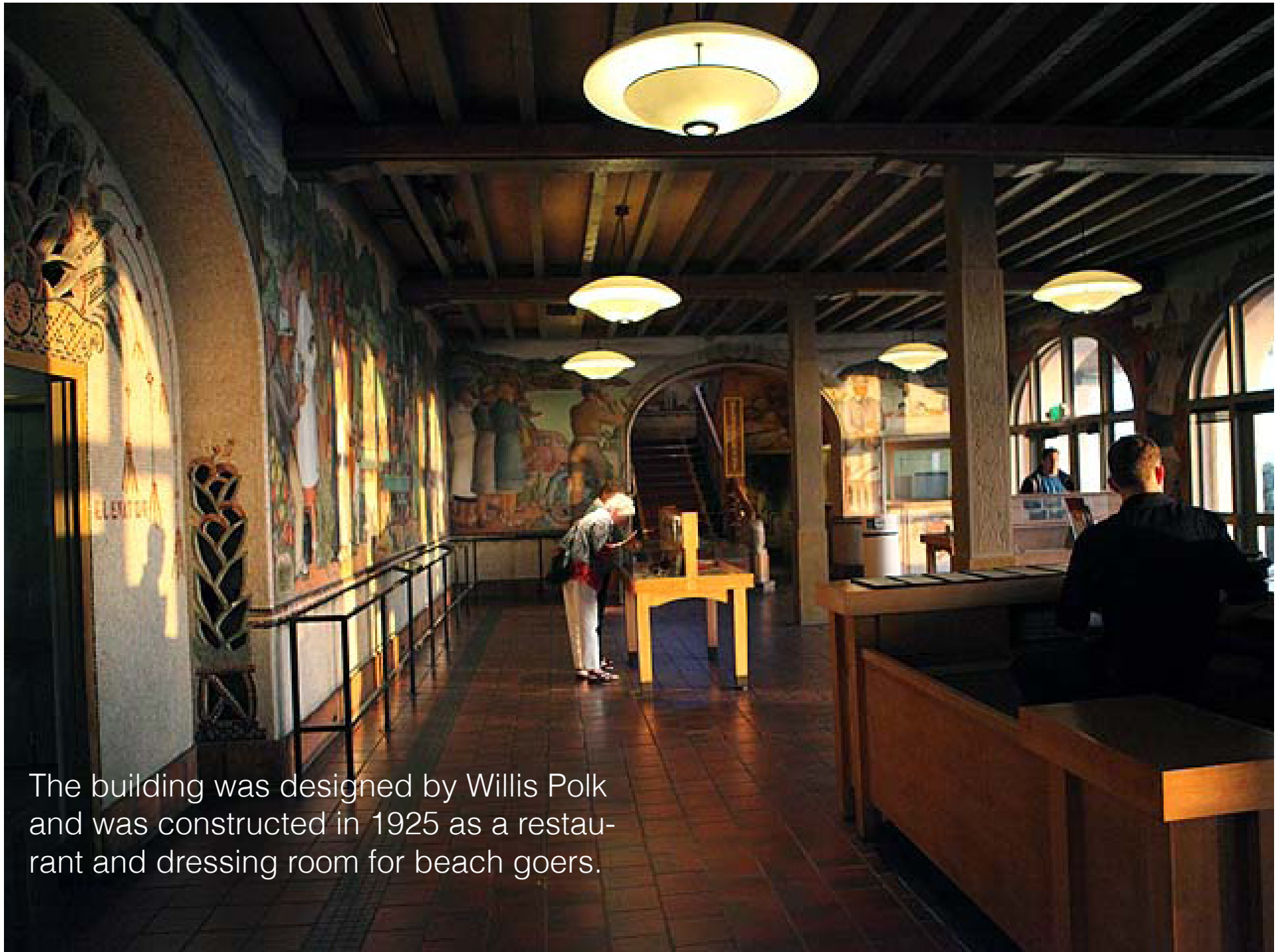






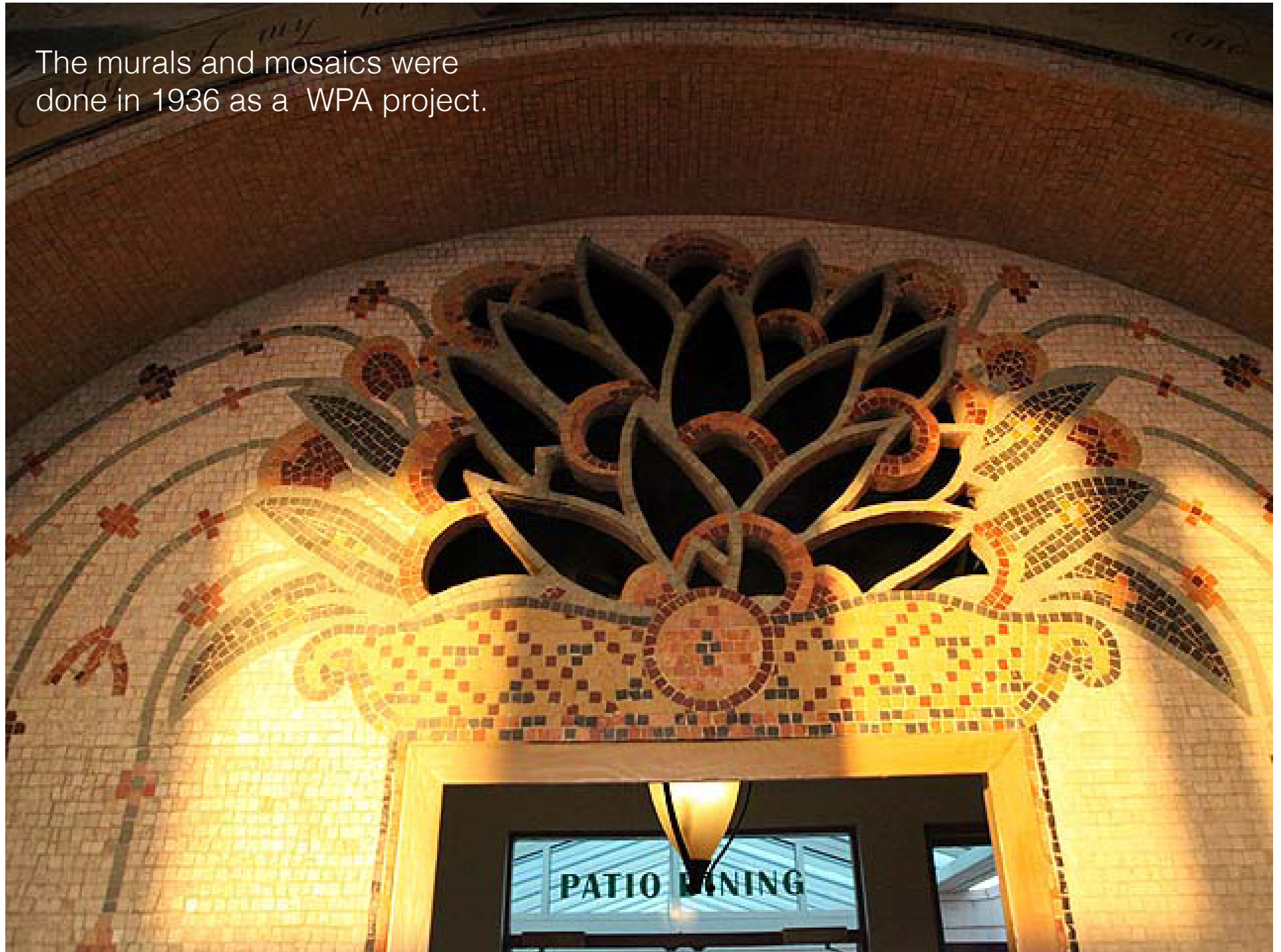






The building was designed by Willis Polk and was constructed in 1925 as a restaurant and dressing room for beach goers.
