















Amador City is a city. It has a city hall. The population is only 185. It was incorporated in 1915. The city began in 1863. (April 2007)





















The old mine across from the city hall. (April 2007)












Sutter Creek became a town in 1854 and an incorporated city in 1913. It has a population of 2,500. (April 2007)






















## **Jackson Tailing Wheels**
