


Trip #1: Mokelumne River fish hatchery

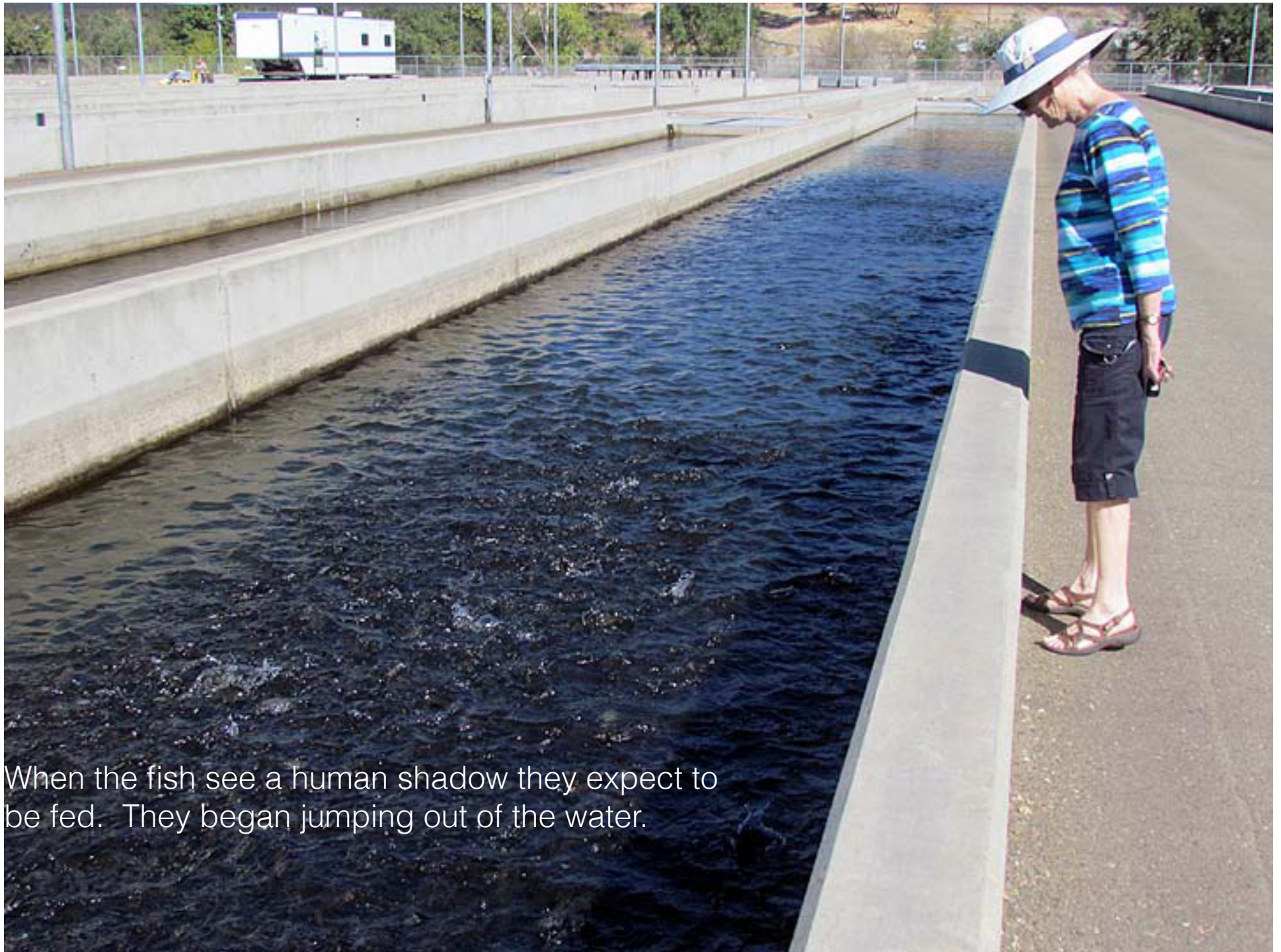

into these long ponds

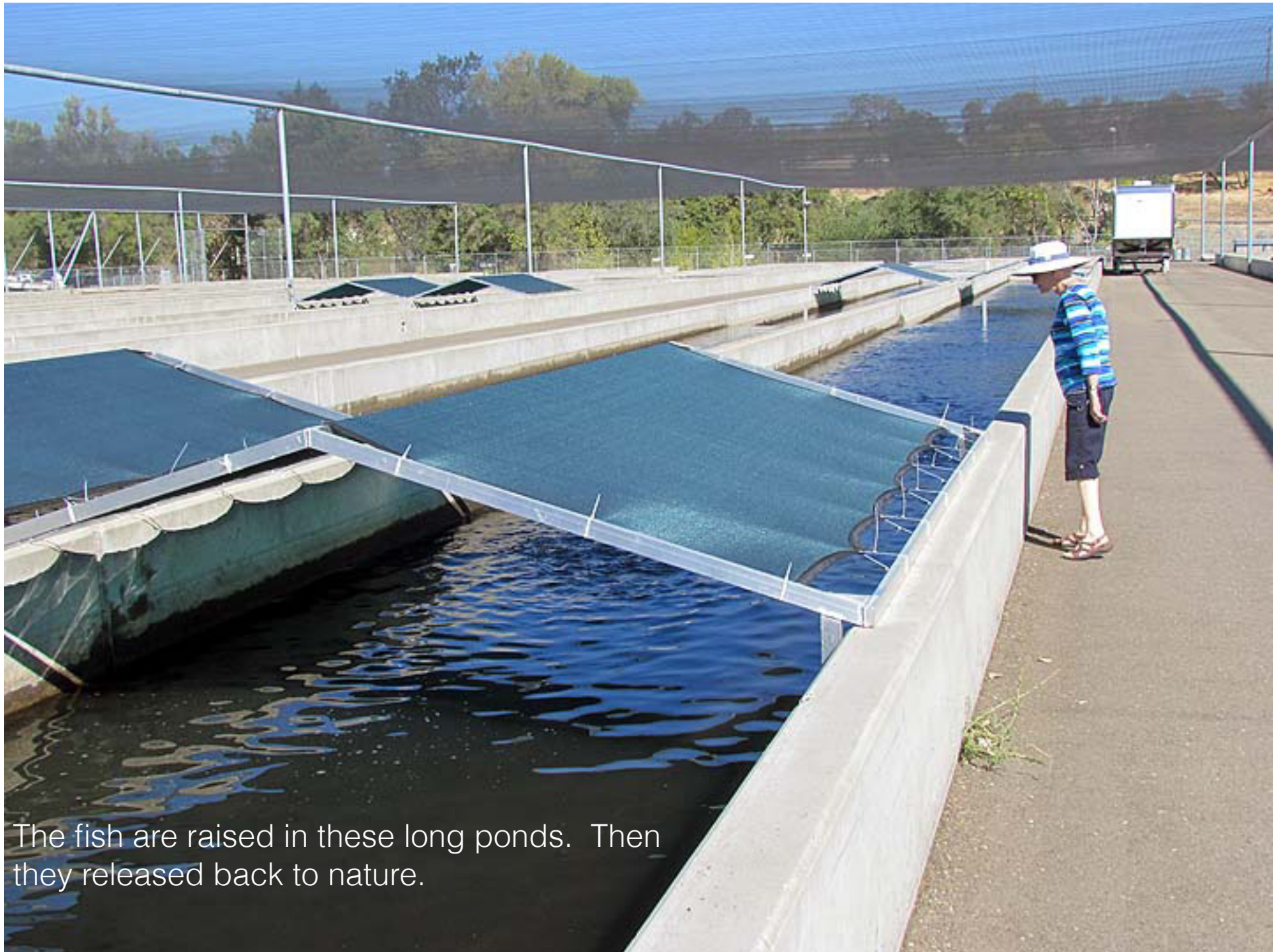


The hatchery breeds two types of fish - chinook salmon and steelhead (sea going trout.) Chinook breed only once and die. Steelhead breed ,more than once.





The chinook enter the fish hatchery through a ladder from the river. The females are sliced open and the eggs are dumped into a shallow pan where they are fertilized.



The fish are raised in these long ponds. Then they released back to nature.







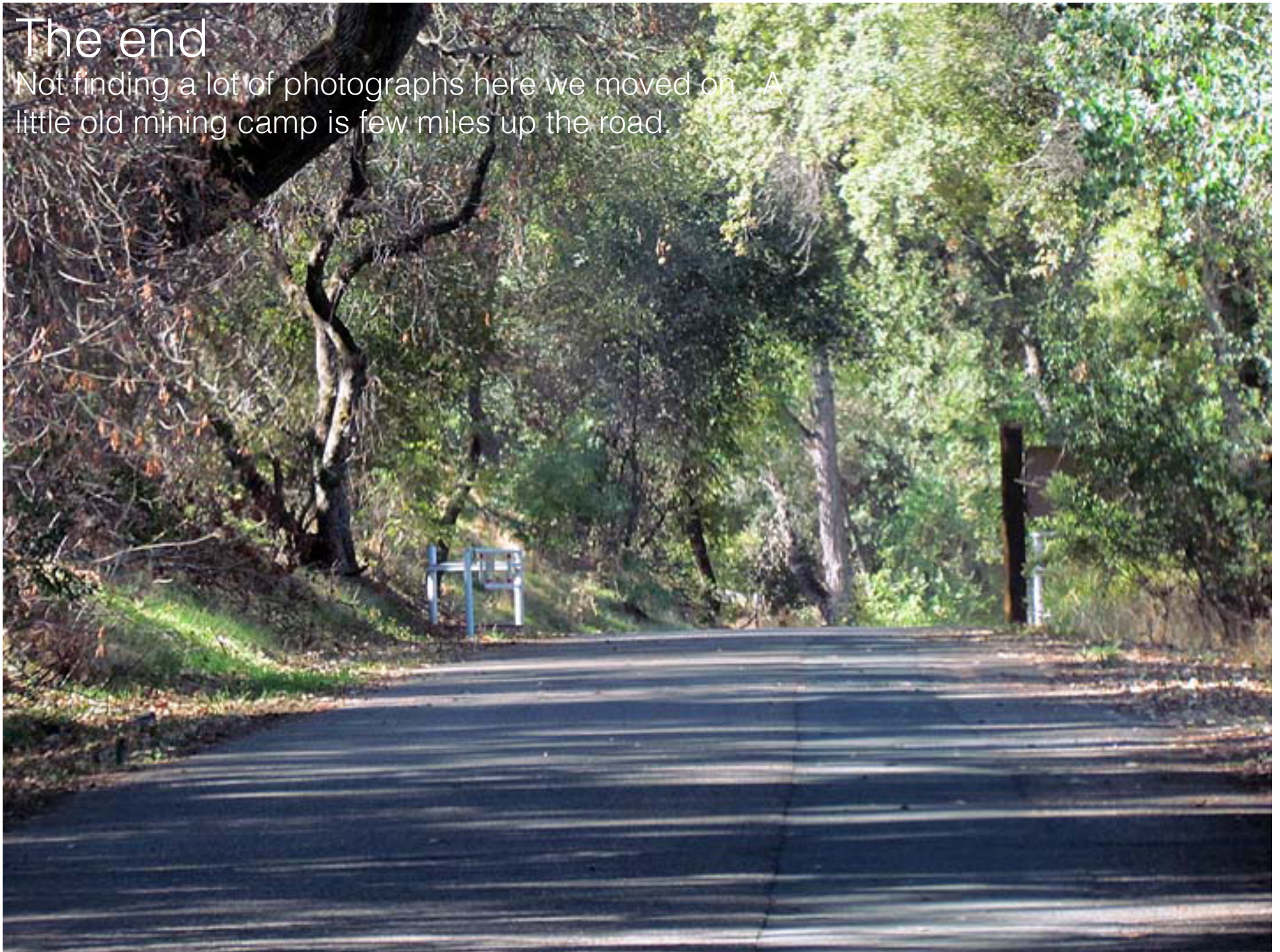
This is a tour group on top of the dam.



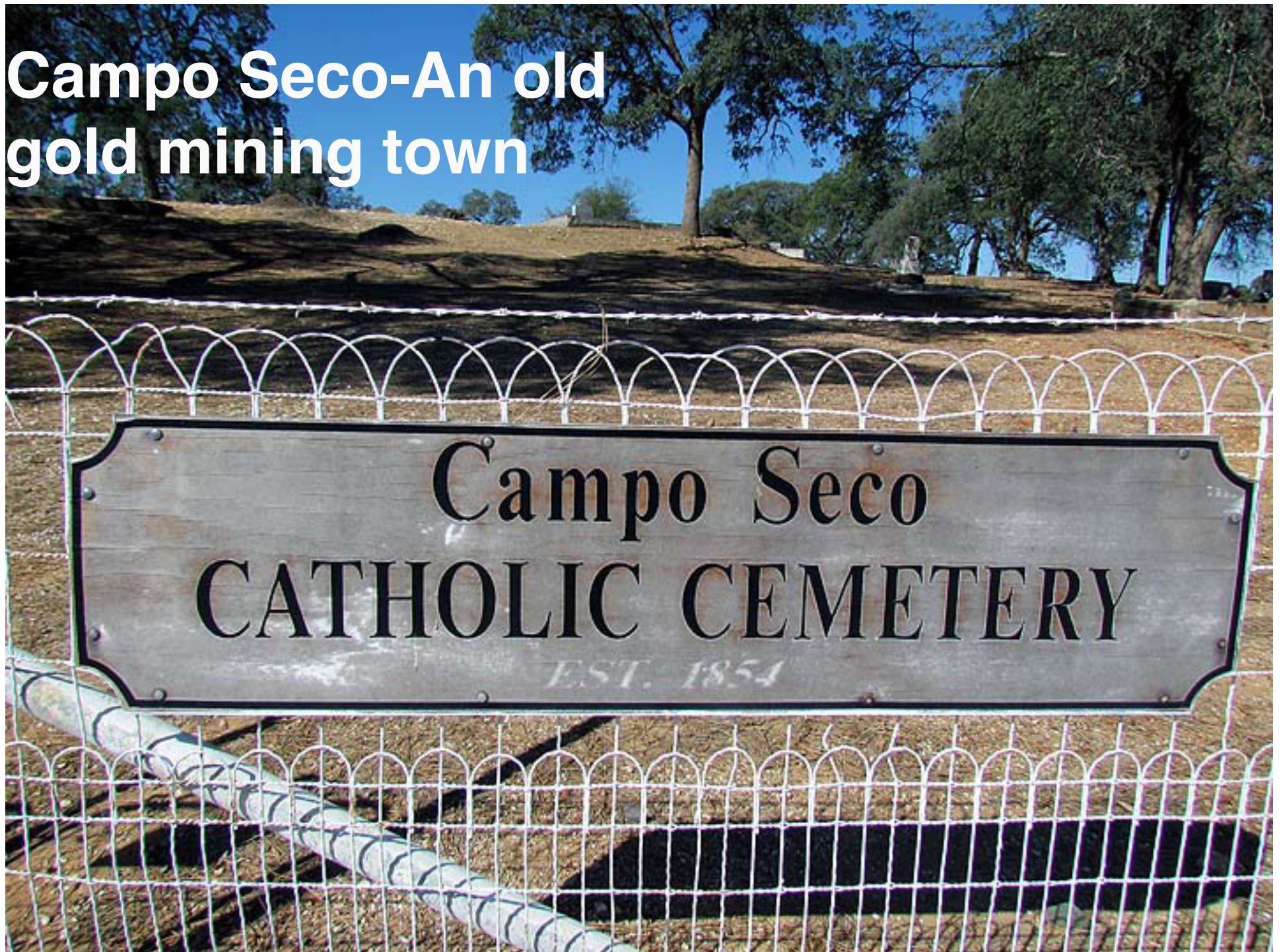


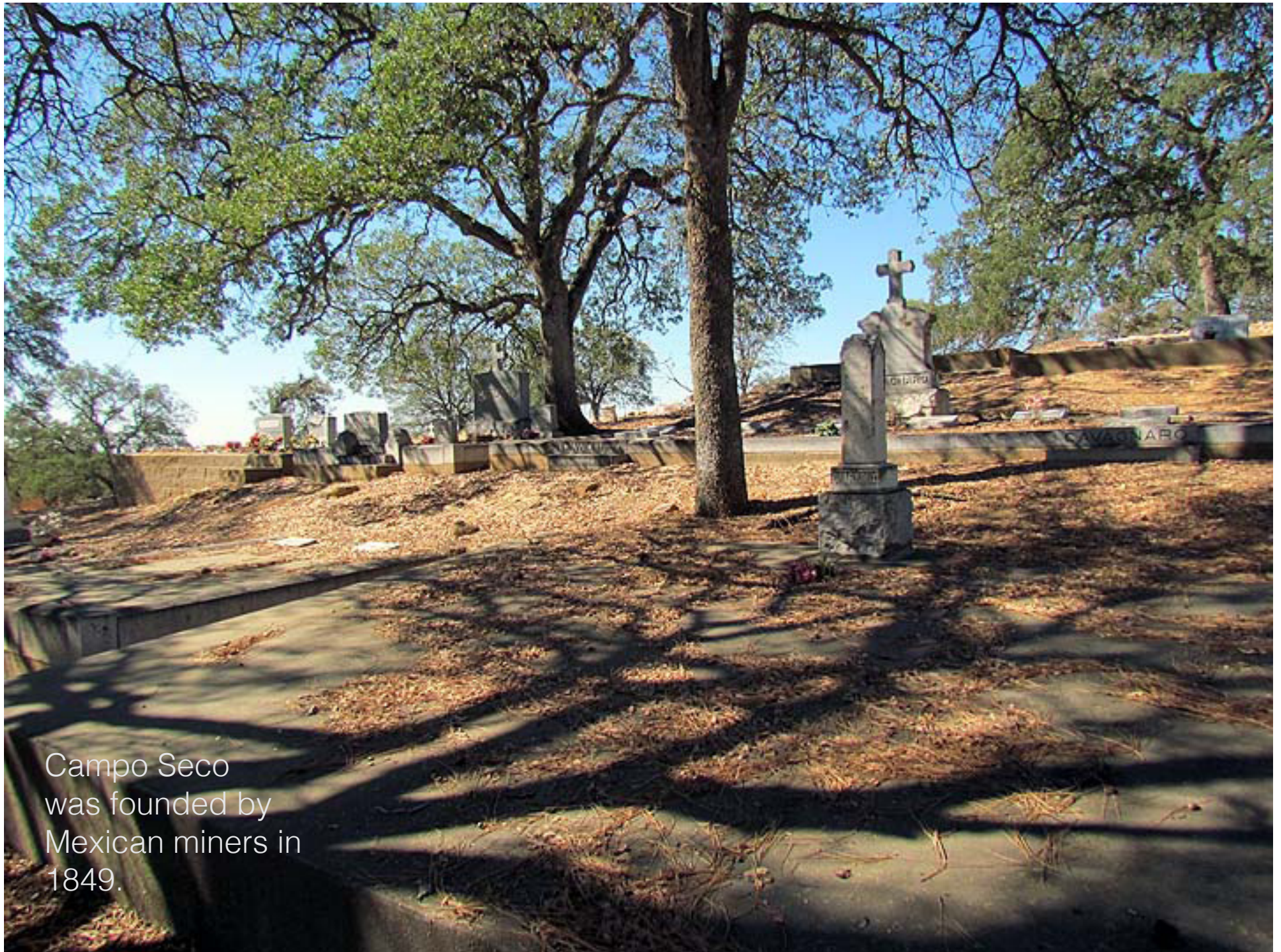
The end
