

## Fresno County































## **Parlier**

The railroad and packing houses filled this area in downtown. There is nothing to replace the missing buildings. (October 2005)








## Reedley

Reedley has a population of 24,000. The town slogan is "The World's Fruit Basket." It was incorporated in 1913. (March 2003)

















































## **Orange Cove**
