





















The city dates back to 1888. It incorporated in 1962. The population is 152,720. This is the Superior Courthouse. (April 2004)

The Skunk Works is a place where secret aircraft such as the SX71, which was a spy plane, were designed (May 2005)




The Pearblossom Highway (Highway 138) stretches from Palmdale to Antelope Valley. (April 2004)
