




The school is just south of downtown Los Angeles. It was founded in 1880. Today it has 17,000 undergraduates and 20,000 graduate students. (December 2003)


MacArthur Park, Eastlake and Echo Lake all began as reservoirs for the city. (June 2004)



This is the old Ambassador Hotel where Bobby Kennedy was assassinated. It was in the process of being torn down and replaced by a school. (June 2004)




Los Angeles Contemporary Art Museum
