














### Mt. Washington

Looking down on Los Angeles from Mt. Washington, a multi-ethnic neighborhood to the northeast of downtown. (May 2005)




# Mt. Washington

The county hospital dates back to 1878. It became associated with USC in 1885. It has 600 beds. (May 2005)








#### **Boyle Heights**














# **Highland Park**


Highland Park is a hill that overlooks downtown. It is northeast of downtown. Mostly Hispanic today. (May 2005)










#### **Elysian Park**
