










The Hotel Marmont was built on Sunset in 1927. It is an historic landmark. (May 2009)



















The Roosevelt was completed in 1927. It has 300 rooms. (May 2009)











Canter's began in Jersey City in 1924. It is a famous Jewish deli on Fairfax, but it is no longer Kosher. (June 2004)



Grauman's Chinese theatre was built in 1927. (June 2004)





























The City Hall on Santa Monica Blvd. The population is 34,000. (June 2005)




Beverly Hills


