


The community dates back to the Encino Rancho which was founded in 1845. The Rancho is now a park and Encino is one of the towns along Ventura Blvd.(June 2004)


































This town was incorporated in 1982. The population is 20,330. (June 2004)












Griffith J. Griffith donated the land and money for the observatory in 1896. The building was completed in 1935. (May 2009)


