

The town was started way back in 1870. It didn't become incorporated until 1957. The population has grown to 90,000. (July 2004)










Part of the city hall grounds is a lovely rose garden featuring prize winning beauties. (July 2004)











Behind the city hall is a large memorial to Vietnam War vets. (July 2004)








#### **Garden Grove**

The Crystal Cathedral was constructed in 1981. It was designed by Philipp Johnson. Recently it was purchased by the Catholic Church. (December 2009)





The exterior is covered by 10,000 panes of glass. (December 2009)




Orange is the only city in Orange County built around a town square. The town plaza has been on the National Register of Historic places since 1997. (July 2004)















The town was founded in 1869 and was incorporated in 1888. (July 2004)








# **Chapman University**

























Santa Ana was founded in 1869. It has a population of 324,000. (July 2004)
