






## **Morro Bay**

The town was founded in 1870 and it served as a port for shipping dairy products. It is also is the spot were the first Filipino immigrants landed in 1587. That is not a typo.















Morro Bay as seen from the Montano de Oro State Park to the south of Morro Bay.(August 2010)




The population is 1,627. It has been a port for San Luis Obispo since the 19th Century. When we shot these photos the community was in the middle of a building boom. (August 2005)
