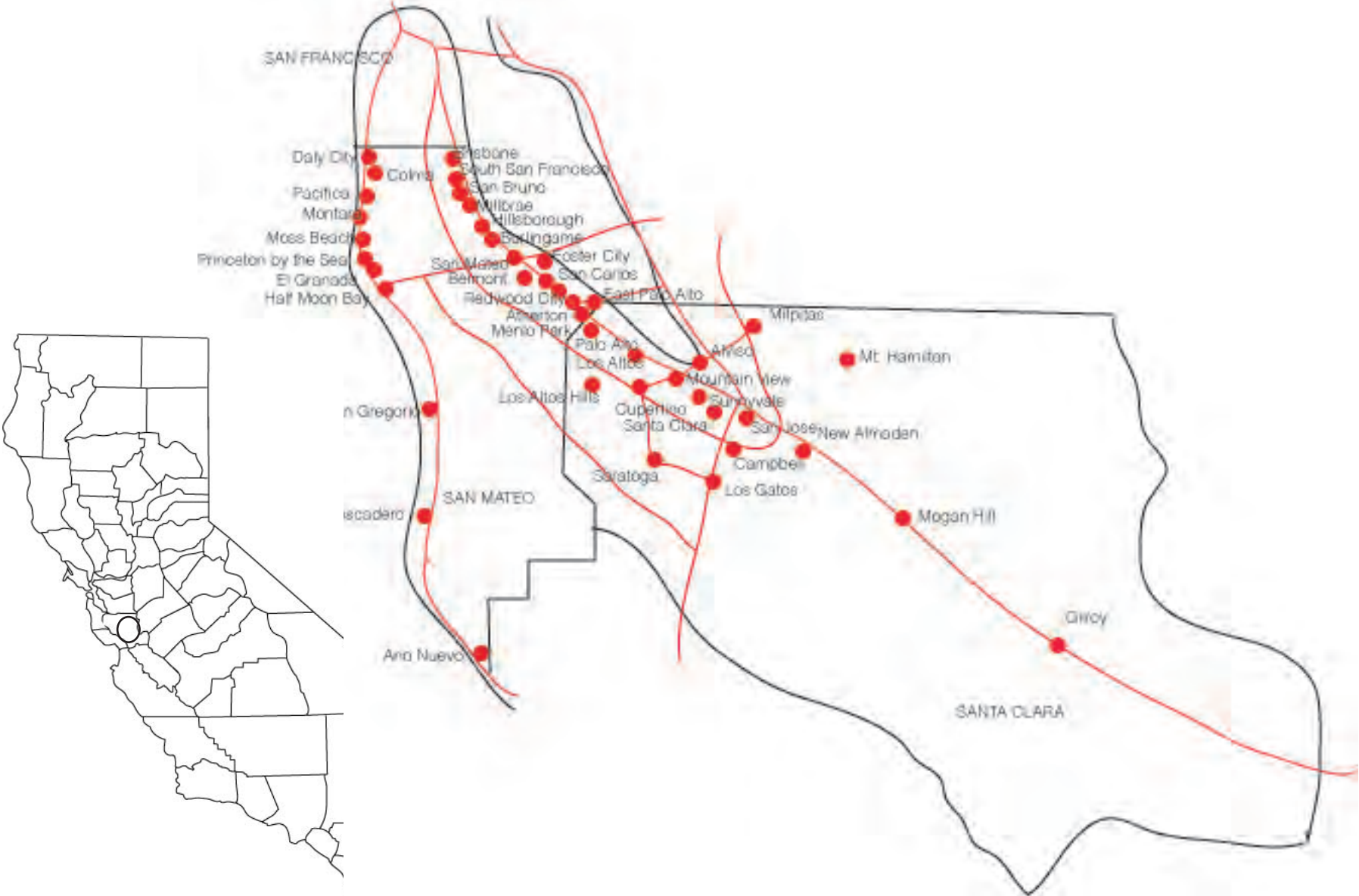

# Mt. Hamilton

Mt. Hamilton is 4,196 feet high. A 19 mile road was built in 1875-76 to carry supplies for the building of Lick Observatory. The observatory was constructed from 1876 to 1887. It is still a functioning observatory operated by the University of California. (April 2005)
